



Announcement of the National Bureau of Agricultural Commodity and Food Standards
Subject: Declaration of Anti-Corruption Commitment

In recognition of the importance of integrity and fairness in society, the National Bureau of Agricultural Commodity and Food Standards (ACFS) hereby establishes its policy on anti-corruption, both in terms of the prevention and suppression of corruption, specifically with regard to bribery, conflicts of interest, and all forms of unethical conduct. The ACFS is fully committed to upholding transparency, moral and ethical standards, and social responsibility, while fostering a culture of good governance in its operations to ensure public trust and confidence in the administration and conduct of its personnel.

The ACFS, comprising executives, government officers and employees, including all other staff members, hereby makes this declaration of intent to adhere to the following principles in order to achieve the aforementioned policies, in accordance with the Ethical Standards Act B.E. 2562 (2019):

1. Conduct management and operations with the highest standards of integrity, ethics, and good governance, aiming to maximize benefits for the nation and Thai people.
2. Strictly comply with the anti-corruption policy by preventing and combating all forms of corruption, conflicts of interest, and bribery, while refraining from engaging in or being associated with any corrupt activities, either directly or indirectly.
3. Actively oppose and strictly monitor all forms of corruption, ensuring that such activities are not tolerated under any circumstances. The ACFS commits to not overlooking or ignoring any suspected instances of corruption and stands ready to fully cooperate in investigations, ensuring fairness and protection for government officers and employees, staff members, or any other persons providing information or evidence of corrupt practices.
4. Promote and support the performance of duties by government officers and employees, and staff members with fairness, transparency, equality, and professionalism.
5. Continuously foster a culture of integrity and ethical conduct throughout the organization.
6. Encourage all personnel to apply the principles of the sufficiency economy philosophy in their personal lives and professional duties.

This declaration is hereby issued for the information and strict observance of all concerned.
